Welcome to our 'Marathon in a Month' fundraising challenge!



While we'd be delighted if all our little ones completed the walking challenge, we wanted to offer a different option in case a mile a day was too much.

We would love it if children, as individuals or as families, were sponsored to complete our treasure hunt. Over the course of the month, we challenge them to get out and about around Banff and find one object beginning with each letter of the alphabet. We're providing this book to record what they find. They could take a photograph and stick it in, or draw and label a picture of what they found—with help if necessary! They could be sponsored an amount for each letter they complete, or a donation for completing the whole challenge. They could complete several letters on one day if that works for you, and it's OK to miss a day, as long as all letters are completed within the month of the challenge (12th July to 10th August). Don't worry if you can't manage them all!

We'd love it if the children also coloured in the letters and borders in the book and we'd really appreciate any pictures of completed pages for our FaceBook page: the more colourful the better! You might like to read and talk about the Bible verse on each page with your child, or look at one of the extra challenges dotted throughout the book.

All participants for whom we have an address will receive a certificate to thank them for taking part. There will also be a prize for the most creative, completed booklet; if you'd like your child to be considered please return their booklet along with their sponsorship form no later than 31st August.
